

IkamvaYouth

IkamvaYouth is a by-youth, for-youth volunteer-driven township-based non-profit organization established in 2003 with 5 branches in three provinces in South Africa. Through tutoring, mentoring, career guidance, computer literacy classes, life skills development, and creative expression opportunities, IkamvaYouth aims to enable township youth to pull themselves and each other out of poverty and into university and employment

These youth face many obstacles that perpetuate disadvantage. Most township schools produce learners whose academic performance is below grade level. Poor matric results and low awareness of post-school opportunities lead to high numbers of unemployed youth (estimated at over 60% in Khayelitsha). Currently fewer than 10% of South African youth access higher education (SAIRR, 2009) of which only a fraction come from township or rural communities. Most learners in township schools do not receive the skills development opportunities afforded their more privileged counterparts in the suburbs, including computer literacy and extra-mural activities. In addition to the difficulties that living in poverty and receiving a sub-standard education brings, many township youth are infected and/or affected by HIV/AIDS.

IkamvaYouth's impact is unprecedented. With matric rates between 87-100% since 2005 and 70% of learners over the past 3 years accessing tertiary education, learnerships or employment after matric, Ikamvanites are exceeding national averages at every step. Ex-learners are instilled with the value of paying-it-forward, and over 50% of our learners return to volunteer their time at their respective branches. This model is an innovative high impact, low cost model. It costs about R3000 per learner to participate in the programme per year, which is a small price to pay for supporting the learner to develop as an individual and to enable and inspire them to take their futures into their own hands.
